

# SAN FRANCISCO TOURS

## **Friday, September 13** Muir Woods, Sausalito & Ferry \$57.00 each

Depart Doubletree Hotel 8:00 AM. Proceed to Muir Woods Redwood Tree National Monument via Golden Gate Bridge. We will stop at the bridge overlook for photo ops on the way. There will be a two hour tour of the Visitor center and Giant Red Wood forest, a remnant of the ancient coastal forest that blanketed the coast before the 1800's. Many of the trees are 600 to 2000 years old, and are up to 379 feet tall and 22 feet in diameter. We will then proceed to the bayside city of Sausalito, a quaint waterfront town with many shops, sights and restaurants. We will all be on our own for lunch. We will all board the 3:00 PM ferry to San Francisco for a cruise across San Francisco Bay, providing views of both Alcatraz and the Golden Gate Bridge. Our Motor coach will have gone on to San Francisco Pier 39 where it will meet the 3:00 PM ferry and return us to the hotel at 4:00 PM.

## **Saturday, September 14** Mare Island & Vineyard \$68.00 each

Depart the Hotel at 8:00 AM and proceed to the Mare Island Naval Shipyard Museum, Vallejo, crossing the Bay Bridge and the Carquinez Straits Bridge. We will tour the former Naval shipyard including the dry docks, chapel, and museum.

We will have a 1 hour visit to the city of Sonoma for lunch on our own before proceeding to a Sonoma Valley vineyard to experience the winemaking process.

A wine tasting will be available for those who wish to sample the wines at an additional fee.

Return to the hotel by 4:00 PM

## **Sunday, September 15** San Francisco City & Pier 39 \$54.00 each

Depart the hotel 8:00 AM. We will tour the sights of the city of San Francisco with several stop off points in the morning.

In the afternoon we will be on our own at Pier 39 for lunch and browsing. The pier features many shops and restaurants, and attractions. The Sea Lion Colony on the adjacent piers and docks can be observed from pier 39

For those who want to explore, there are several museums in the nearby waterfront area, the maritime museum, (additional fee), and the San Francisco Maritime National Historical Park, including 8 historical vessels, (additional fee \$5.00)

Reboard the coach at pier 39 at 2:15 PM for the return to the hotel by 3:00 PM
